Trip Information:

General: Students will learn basic belay techniques and reinforce their knowledge of a figure-8 knot on the assigned day after school. Students will then go to Lighthouse Park and use these skills to climb a cliff face in Lighthouse Park in groups of three (climber, belayer, and back-up belayer).

Cost: \$25 - Covers transportation and equipment use.

Supervision: There are two supervisors going on the trip with at least one supervisor having extensive experience with rock climbing.

Risk Assessment:

Location	Lighthouse Park - rock bluffs by the ocean
Camping	N/A
Fitness Requirement	Average overall body strength.
Weather	Students need to be prepared for sunny (sunburns) and/or windy conditions. In case of rain, the trip will have to be cancelled.
Medical problems	Possible tendon strains in hand and/or forearm; sprained ankles; cuts, scrapes, and bruises.
